Awardees of "Future Stars - Upward Mobility Scholarship" are encouraged to apply for the Future Stars Mentoring Programme. Successful candidates will be matched with an experienced mentor, who will provide guidance and assist our awardees in their exploration of life planning.

Targets	Nominees of "Future Stars - Upward Mobility Scholarship"
How to apply	Register at the same time as submission of scholarship nomination
Programme period	Jun 2021 to Jan 2022
Quota	180 students

Applicants are required to go through an interview and attend all activities under the Mentoring Programme.

A student's chance of being awarded the scholarship **WILL NOT** be affected by whether or not he/ she enrolls for the Mentoring Programme.

The "Future Stars - Upward Mobility Scholarship" of the Commission on Poverty aims to encourage youths who demonstrate resilience in adversity and maintain a positive attitude towards life and learning by way of scholarships of HK\$5000 raised from all walks of the community. Over 460 secondary schools participated each year with over 7600 students having benefitted to date.

Targets Secondary 3 to 6 students with the following attributes:

1. A positive attitude and persistence in the face of adversity;
2. A positive value and attitude towards life;
3. Aspiration and determination to move upwards socially; and
4. Potential and prominent progress in academic performance and/or personal growth.

How to apply Nomination by teachers or social workers, which should be submitted via the school

Quota Each school can nominate up to 3 students

Students are welcome to put themselves forward to their schools for consideration.
