


# Overview of Accomplishments In Three Priority Areas



## Food Support Flagship Project



- Collaborative platform FOOD-CO launched in May 2017 to enhance effectiveness and efficiency of food support service
- Target to increase the number of hot meals and packaged food items to 50 000 daily and **beneficiaries to more than 22 000** by end 2019

## Community Housing Movement




- Launched in September 2017 to provide affordable transitional accommodation for low-income families
- Jointly sponsor the operating expenditure with the Community Chest for three years

## Social Entrepreneurship School Education Programme



- Run from September 2015 to December 2017 to enhance awareness of secondary school students on social innovation and entrepreneurship

## Social Innovation Design Lab



- Two-year project launched in April 2017 to train young designers to be enablers for future social innovation
- Recruit young designers to co-create innovative solutions with the elderly to address their needs
