

Commission on Poverty Visits the To Kwa Wan Community Living Room

Transcript of Cantonese short video

Voiceover:

The Chief Secretary for Administration, Chan Kwok-ki, and the Secretary for Labour and Welfare, Chris Sun together with members of the Commission on Poverty(CoP) members visited the Community Care Fund-supported To Kwa Wan Community Living Room(CLR) to observe how it assists “subdivided unit”(SDU) households by providing additional living space and community connections.

Beyond core facilities like the shared pantry, dining area, living room and children’s playing corner, study room, washing and dryer machines and shower room, the CLR offers additional facilities including the band room, multimedia room, fitness room, nursery room and “Lending Corner”.

The fully-equipped shared pantry features multiple cooking stations, large refrigerators, dish sterilisers and diverse cookware. CoP members joined CLR members

preparing fried vegetable stuffed with fish paste and dumplings together while inviting their feedback on the CLR.

Music enthusiasts use the band room to practice and compose music free from space limitation at home to enjoy fully the fun of music.

The CLR prioritises wellness with a bright gym.

The visit concluded at the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals sponsored food bank stocked with donated goods redeemable by participation points earned by CLR members.

year-round offering free membership to local SDU households.
